2011 First Saturday Club

Saturday, Feb. 5, March 5, April 2, etc. 8:30-11am
A new series starts February 2011

This year we are using another terrific pattern by Lori Smith of From My Heart to Your Hands. We will be making 12” blocks in two different colorways: Batik or Reproduction. There will also be two different setting options for the blocks, and you will receive both in with your month 1 pattern. You can do the pieced or appliqued center for either colorway.

FOR 2011: You will register for the First Saturday Club ahead of time by paying the \$18.00 (+ tax) pattern fee. You have to register and pay the fee ahead of time to participate. We need to know how many patterns to purchase! You can start the Club any time after it begins, because we can get more patterns as needed.

Here's how it works:

- * You will sign up by paying the pattern fee of \$18.00, hopefully before Jan. 22.
- * We will open the doors at 8:30 on the First Saturday, starting February 5, 2011. You will pay \$5 the first month you come, then it's free if you bring the completed block back, or just \$5.00.
- * When you come in from 8:30-11 on the First Saturday, you'll show your completed block at the door to get the free ticket (starting in March). Then you can go to the demo area, where there will be a display of new items, a small ongoing demonstration, and a staff member highlighting that month's block.

There are a few conditions:

- * If you want to make a block in more than one colorway, that's great. But, you only get 1 free kit a month. You must pay for the others.
- * To get your free kit, you have to come yourself on the First Saturday between 8:30 and 11 am. No exceptions. Don't be late! Don't send someone else to get your block!
- * If you can't come one Saturday, you can buy that month's kit for \$5.00 while supplies last. You can call us and we'll be happy to save a kit for you. Bring it to the next month's class and that month's kit is free.
- * Both colorways are very scrappy, and we'll have a variety of fat quarters available each month to make extra blocks or scrappy borders. The fabrics might not be what's in the block, depending on the availability of the fabrics. Scrappy is great!
